Information for new arrivals

This leaflet is an introduction to the local communities and their life. Please keep it for reference.

Terriers (named after the big house on Terriers Green) is a mainly residential district on the edge of High Wycombe. There are shops on Amersham Road (including a Tesco Express and "Archie's Stores", a local newsagent and general store). You will also find an Asian restaurant ("The Spice Lounge"), a Chinese take-away ("Mr Chan") and a fish-and chip shop. The local schools are Highworth County Combined School, Kingswood County Combined School and the Royal Grammar School (a selective secondary school for boys).

Local community buildings are

- St Francis Church Hall in Amersham Road (*a modern, purpose-built resource for the whole community in Terriers and beyond. It hosts the activities of many groups. St Francis Church Hall may also be booked for public meetings and for private functions. - Totteridge Community Centre in Totteridge Drive (*a recently refurbished community building in traditional style. It hosts a number of groups. The Centre may also be booked for public meetings and for private functions. Please telephone Steve on 01494 511216*)
